## American Revolution Review

- French and Indian War: resulted in an English victory and caused the English to look for ways to pay for the war
- Taxes: King George III taxed the colonies to pay for the war
- No taxation without representation: colonists had no say in Parliament but were taxed like the English living in England
- Examples of Acts/Taxes: Stamp Act, Townsend Duties, Tea Tax, Intolerable Acts, Quartering Act, the Port of Boston Act
- Examples of Incidents/Events: Boston Massacre, Tea Party
- Declaration of Independence: Jefferson was inspired by Locke
- American Revolution: American were victorious and had help from the French
- The American Government: heavily influenced by the Enlightenment, Constitution outlined government, and Bill of Rights limited government and protected people's rights
