

French Revolution “Highs and Lows” Timeline 3.6

1. You will be creating a timeline of the French Revolution.
2. You will choose the 10 most significant events that occurred throughout the duration of the Reign of Terror. If you need help with determining what the important events were, see Mrs. Toxqui ASAP.
3. For each event, you’ll determine whether it was a “high” (positive thing) or a “low” (negative thing) for the French people. This will determine where you place the event on the line. “Highs” go above the timeline line, and “lows” go below the timeline line.
4. All events must be placed in chronological order with the month/year (if available – you may just find years for some events) included.
5. For each event, you will do the following:
 - a. List the name of the event
 - b. Include the date (month/year if available or at least the year)
 - c. Write 2-3 sentences both 1) explaining what happened at the event and 2) explaining why it was a “high” or “low” point.
 - d. Draw a relevant image that relates to the event.
6. You can use both sides of a piece of printer paper and coloring supplies to complete this.
