<u>Time Magazine: Person of the Year Assignment Directions</u>

Step 1: Choose the "Person of the Year."

- Decide which of the following Chinese leaders had the greatest impact during the collapse of Imperial China to the temporary pause of the Chinese Civil War (approximately 1911-1937).
 - Sun Yixian (AKA Sun Yat-Sen)
 - Jiang Jieshi (AKA Chiang Kai-shek)
 - Mao Zedong

Step 2: Research that person.

- Conduct research using the Chromebooks and pg. 448-452 of your textbook to take individual notes on your "person of the year." Your notes should cover these topics:
 - Biographical information
 - Role and involvement in the collapse of Imperial China and/or the Chinese Civil War from 1911-1937
 - Major actions or accomplishments from 1911-1937
 - Interesting or significant facts
 - o Etc.

Step 3: Create your magazine cover.

- Use the provided template to make your cover.
- Create a hand-illustrated background that contains symbols or scenes related to that person.
- Write a caption that includes the name and title of the person your chose.
- Cut out the picture of the leader your chose and glue it on the cover.

 - Write at least two complete paragraphs
 - Include relevant and significant details about:
 - Biographical information
 - Role and involvement in China from 1911-1937
 - Major actions or accomplishments from 1911-1937
 - Interesting or significant facts
 - Thoroughly explain WHY this person is influential
 - Write clearly with minimal grammatical or spelling errors
- Write a creative and original title at the top of the article.
